You are invited to submit a paper (max. 5 pages) for the IIPhDW 2016. The paper should follow exactly the form outlined in the template. Each author is expected to emphasize the main points and novel features of his or her work, including the results. The paper should be submitted in the DOC/DOCX and PDF format (packed into a single ZIP file) directly via the workshop website.

## WORKING LANGUAGE

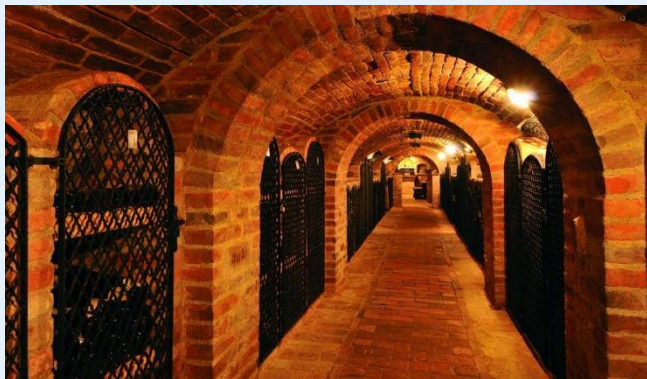
